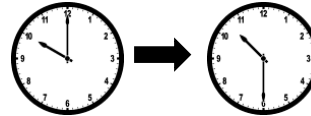


This is St Peter's Church



On Sundays there is a service called **Church Around the Table**

People arrive between 10 O'clock and half past 10.



There are hot and cold drinks available. People can chat or sit at a table.



The vicar is called Jonathan Phillips.



The service starts at half past 10.



Everyone sits at a table.

Most Sundays, the same things happen at the front of the church. There is a visual timetable on the wall to show what order they will happen. Usually it happens in this order:



Hello and welcome



Light a candle. This reminds us of Jesus who said he is the light of the world.



Sorry prayer



Song (Someone will do signs with their hands to help us understand the words)



Saying the Creed – what Christians believe



Bible reading and a someone talking about it (about 5 minutes)



Thinking and talking with the people on your table

Church Around the Table Social Story



Prayers



Song



A blessing prayer



Notices – what is happening over the next week

Afterwards people can have another drink if they want.



Most people go home at about 11.45.



Sometimes at Church Around the Table we share bread and wine to remind us that Jesus died for us. This is called 'Communion'. It happens after the prayers and before the second song.
