Lent – Living Hope- Week 6: Transformation

John 16:7-13

Introduction to the Confession:

God shows his love for us in that, while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Let us then show our love for him

by confessing our sins in penitence and faith. (cf Romans 5.8)

Collect:

True and humble king, hailed by the crowd as Messiah: grant us the faith to know you and love you, that we may be found beside you on the way of the cross, which is the path of glory.

Hymn: All Hail King Jesus

Unless I go away, the Advocate will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you. ⁸ When he comes, he will prove the world to be in the wrong about sin and righteousness and judgment: ⁹ about sin, because people do not believe in me; ¹⁰ about righteousness, because I am going to the Father, where you can see me no longer; ¹¹ and about judgment, because the prince of this world now stands condemned.
