Introduction to Confession:

Reading:

11:11 Through the blessing of the upright a city is exalted,

but by the mouth of the wicked it is destroyed.

- ¹² Whoever derides their neighbour has no sense, but the one who has understanding holds their tongue.
- ¹³ A gossip betrays a confidence, but a trustworthy person keeps a secret.
- 12: ¹⁸ The words of the reckless pierce like swords, but the tongue of the wise brings healing.

18: ²¹The tongue has the power of life and death, and those who love it will eat its fruit.

26:¹⁷ Like one who grabs a stray dog by the ears is someone who rushes into a quarrel not their own.

¹⁸ Like a maniac shooting flaming arrows of death

- If you do not wish to receive wine please feel no compulsion to do so.

 If you do not wish to receive communion but would like to be prayed for, when you come forward, keep your hands by your side and we will pray for you.
